International Puppy LLC Presents International Puppy 2019 Contest Application & Contestant Guide



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Contest Rules:

Each International Contestant:

- 1. Must be at least twenty one (21) years of age at the time of the event. Verification to be completed at the Contestants' Meeting at the beginning of the weekend.
- 2. Must be either (a) the current or most recently eligible titleholder from a local or regional contest or (b) sponsored at least two community-based organizations or businesses.
- 3. Must agree to appear onstage wearing appropriate gear and participate in all judging categories while conforming to all State and local regulations pertaining to nudity and obscenity laws. For the purpose of this contest, genital area must be covered at all times while in public and a one inch (1") strip of material must cover the anus at all times while in public, and on female pups nipples must also be covered while in public unless in areas where nudity is permitted.
- 4. Must own all gear worn onstage during the contest.
- 5. Must agree upon winning the title to represent the International Puppy Title, if throughout their title year and refrain from competing in any Leather/Puppy/Rubber/Fetish Contest until the conclusion of their International Puppy Title year.
- 6. Must agree to permit onstage photographs to be taken for the use on the International Puppy, International Puppy Club, International Puppy and Handler weekend, websites or related publications of IPC's discretion.

Contestants should arrive at the host hotel no later than 4:00pm Friday July 13, 2018 and should appear at all scheduled events during International Puppy and Handler Weekend July 12 - 15, 2018.

Contestants are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to arrive Thursday July 12, 2018 or no later than Friday by 4 pm July 13, 2018 and depart no sooner than Sunday evening. Monday Departure would allow contestants time to decompress after their busy weekend of competition and allow for any travel delays/conflicts.

Contestant Deadlines:

REQUIRED - Deadline for contestants for IPC is 4:00 pm Friday, July 13 2018.

Contestants must bring 8 copies of their Application (pages 9 - 11), 1 copy of the Release Form (page 12), 1 Copy of their ID, 1 Auction Basket and their Contestant Fee. Contestants must sell 2 Advertisements for the Program either Half (1/2) Page or Full Page advertisements. Advertisement Prices can be found at: www.INTL-pup.com under the Advertise Tab. Deadline for Ads are June 24, 2018, and should be emailed to Joe@puppygraphics.com Advertisers should put your name in the email so we know who sold the ads. If ads are not sold you must bring 1 additional basket per ad.

Registration:

During registration all contestants will meet with 2 members of the Production Staff. During this time the Executive Producer (s) will go over the do's and don'ts during the weekend while competition is going on. They will also give you tips for interviews, speeches and will go over any requests to ensure that all props are within the IPC Standards and Safety. At this time you will also meet with our Stage Crew to go over what they will need to do to ensure your scene goes smoothly.

Backstage Assistants:

Contestants are permitted one (1) Backstage Assistant to assist in wardrobe changes for both portions of the contest. Contestants with Interpreters are allowed one (1) additional backstage assistant, only if their Interpreter is not assisting with wardrobe changes. Backstage Assistants are required to be present for pre-contest rehearsal and walk through. Backstage space is limited so please utilize IPC's Den Puppy first. Contestants must notify us during Registration on Friday of their Backstage Assistant to ensure they receive a Staff Badge

IPC's Contestant Handler and Den Staff:

Our Contestant Handler and Den Staff is there to assist you during the contest weekend. They will make sure that you are on time to each event throughout the weekend. During the Contest ensure the Den Staff knows what outfit you will be wearing during each portion of the contest if assistance is needed. The Contestant Handler, Pup Incus, will be in charge of all contestants during IPC Weekend after Registration, and Den Staff report to her.

Interpreters:

If you do not verbally speak or understand English, you must bring an interpreter with you and they must attend all official events and rehearsals with you.

IPC does not have the ability to provide Interpreters for all contestants in need. If you can not bring an Interpreter, Please contact Pup Incus at Pup.Incus@gmail.com prior to June 1, 2018 for assistance.

Your Interpreter will be given an ID Badge that authorizes them full access as long as they are with you. Bring your Interpreter with you to Registration on Friday July 13, 2018 to receive their ID Badge.

Eliminations:

IPC reserve the right to eliminate any contestant or contestants after completion of the Interview and Image & Speech segments of the contest, depending on the total number of contestants. The minimum number of contestants required for the elimination option is eight (8), with only the top five scoring contestants continuing on to the Play Scene category. IPC also reserves the right to eliminate contestants for violations of contest rules.

Contest Categories:

Interview: Interview is 300 of 700 points and the biggest portion of your final score. Your interview will last only 10 minutes. Judges are not to touch or fondle any contestant during the interview and if a question is asked that is inappropriate the Executive Producers or Head Judge can and will stop the question.

- 1. Be in pup gear that best fits your personality, if you wear a hood remember to remove it after you meet the judges.
- 2. Shake hands or paws with the judges when you enter and before you leave, otherwise you could loss points.
- 3. International Puppy does not prepare questions for the judges nor do we approve their questions. Over the years we have seen judges ask about the puppy history, leather history, ask you to chase your tail, what Puppy means to you, what the Puppy Pride Flag means to you and even have you howl a song. If you do not know the answer let the judge know you will get back to them on that question and ensure that you do in writing to all judges (contestants have lost points for not getting back to that judge with an answer).
- 4. Remember our history. You can brush up on the puppy history by going to www.humanpups.com or INTL-pup.com under the History tab

Image & Speech: Image is 100 of 700 points and Speech is 150 of 700 points of your score.

Image: You should wear your best pup gear as if you were representing IPC at an event.

Speech: You will be given 2 minutes for your speech. The Time Keeper will not stop you after the 2 minute limit so if you go over there is a 10% deduction from your total Speech Score. Keep your speech short and to the point speak about what you are passionate about, but you want to ensure that the judges and audience knows what you are talking about. should wear your best pup gear as if you were representing IPC at an event.

Pop Question: The Judges will compose Pop Questions, and after your Speech you will be asked to choose 1 question from the bowl, please read it to yourself and then hand the question to the Emcee to read to the audience. There are no points for this, but it is a show for the audience and there is no wrong or right answers, it is something that you can have fun with and give the audience a good laugh.

Pup Play: Pup Play is 150 of 700 points. Each Puppy contestant will appear onstage while performing a puppy play scene that they have written. The scene can be read by the emcee if requested by the contestant or they can use a sound track (must be on either a CD or USB Drive for the DJ). Judging in this category is based on the contestant's creativity and ability to convey their most playful puppy play scene. Contestants may involve additional pups, or they can request a volunteer staff member to help. Props may be used, but must be approved by the contest producers for safety and compliance with the law. The Pup Scene cannot exceed five (5) minutes in length. (NOTE: The fantasy is to be typed, try to keep it under 150 words and turned in to the Contestant Handler at the Contestant Registration on Friday evening.)

Fraternization with the Judges:

International Puppy Contestants are encouraged to get to know the judges and interact with them. However, contestants shall be prohibited from having private meetings or engaging in any Sexual Activity or Play Scene with the judges prior to the announcement of the contest results.

To avoid accidental violation of this policy, and being disqualified from competing, all contestants and judges must display their ID Badges at all times.

Contestant Suggestions:

The International Puppy Contest is all about having a good time, socializing with fellow fetish community members and promoting the puppy lifestyle.

Contestants are required to participate in the weekend activities to be seen as an active member of the pup & Fetish community. We try our best to allow contestants enough free time to participate and be seen during the weekend while fulfilling the requirements to compete in the contest.

The International Puppy was created to have a great time. We encourage the contestants to have fun and entertain the audience to set this contest apart from many others. We also encourage you to work the Audience and Judges so that you will stand out on stage while competing.

During the contest, contestants are encouraged to demonstrate different pup looks representing the different judged categories. Time is scheduled during the contest, allowing contestants time for gear and look changes. Assistance is available from our Den Staff or your personal assistant that each contestant is allowed. Remember only one person is allowed on stage during your Pup Play scene.

Make sure you come prepared with a back up outfits and gear incase of accidents and blowouts (don't sneeze).

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact our Contestant Producers, Tripp Hutchings and Pup Figaro.

Contest Judging Method:

A panel of seven (7) Judges representing leaders in the community scores International Puppy Contestants. Judging is made up of four (4) categories and using the Olympic Scoring System where the High and Low score is dropped from each category. Bonus points are added to the Judges scores prior to being entered by the Tally Master. Categories and points are outlined below.

In Olympic Scoring System, the high and low score for each contestant in each category is dropped. The remaining scores are totaled for each contestant. The contestant whose overall score is the highest will be declared the winner, then 1st runner up. Total Scores must be above 70% in order for a winner to be announced even if you are the only contestant.

In the event of a tie under the Total Scoring System, the dropped high and low scores will be added back into the contestant scores in each category. In the event of any dispute regarding the tallying of the contest, International Puppy LLC shall make the final determination of the winner and 1st runner up.

Interview - Maximum of 300 points, up to 60 points per judge, Olympic Scoring:

Each contestant will meet with the judging panel offstage and in a closed to the public setting, prior to the second (2nd) portion of the contest to answer questions about the contestant's interests in human puppies, fetishes, knowledge, willingness and ability to represent the title. Interviews will last no longer than 10 minutes each contestant, so it is important to listen to the question being asked by the judges and respond in a concise and complete manner so that all judges have a chance to ask questions of the contestant. If the judges would like to know more, they will ask for additional information. Contestants should shake the judges hands upon entering and leaving the Interview.

Image - Maximum of 100 points, up to 20 points per judge, Olympic Scoring:

Each contestant will appear onstage and be introduced to the audience by the emcee using information provided on the contestant's completed application. Judging in this category is based on how you present yourself as a "Human Puppy".

Speech - Maximum of 150 points, up to 30 points per judge, Olympic Scoring:

You will be given 2 minutes for your speech. The Time Keeper will not stop you after the 2 minute limit so if you go over there is a 10% deduction from your total speech category. Keep your speech short and to the point, speak about what you are passionate about, but you want to ensure the Judges and Audience knows what you are talking about.

Pup Play - Maximum of 150 points, up to 30 points per judge, Olympic Scoring:

Each Puppy contestant will appear onstage while performing a puppy play scene that they have written. The scene can be read by the emcee if requested by the contestant or they can use a sound track (must be on either a CD or USB Drive for the DJ). Judging in this category is based on the contestant's creativity and ability to convey their most playful puppy play scene. Contestants may involve additional pups, or they can request a volunteer staff member to help. Props may be used, but must be approved by the contest producers for safety and compliance with the law. The Pup Scene cannot exceed five (5) minutes in length. (NOTE: The fantasy is to be typed, try to keep it under 150 words and turned in at the Contestant Registration on Friday evening.)

Expectations of the Winner:

- 1. As the Winner of the International Puppy Title, their primary responsibility is:
 - A. Promoting International Puppy Contest.
 - B. Promoting the Human Pup & Handler Community.
- 2. The Winner must hold 2 fundraisers to benefit IPC during their title year...
- 3. The Winner will maintain contact with IPC Producers to inform them of their know travel schedule so that International Puppy can ensure the Titleholder has IPC literature and Giveaway items, it also allows International Puppy to help advertise events that our Titleholder will be at.
- 4. The Winner is requested to judge the following years contest along with their Step Aside Speech.

Winners Prize Package:

The prize package contains the Title Holders patch, Winners medallion, amount of Contest Fees collected, a \$5000.00 Travel Fund Sponsored by Square Peg Toys and if any of the travel fund is left it is to be donated to the charity of your choice. It is also for you to come back at the end of your Title Year. The titleholder is also responsible for any damages to the hotel room or incidental hotel expenses. Both Producers and IPC's CFO (Pup Jaeger) must be contacted on your travels for each month in order for IPC to make your travel arrangements. If you are driving to an event you must turn in your gas receipts to be reimbursed. Any other Sponsor gifts will also be presented to you at the Victory Brunch.

1st Runner-up Prize Package: The 1st Runner-up will receive a Medallion and any Sponsor Donated Items.

Auction Baskets:

All monies raised from the auction baskets goes towards the operation of International Puppy LLC to help make the following year even bigger. No Owner takes a pay and all proceeds go into new and replenish merchandise, and the event weekend & contest.

Each contestant is required to provide one (1) auction basket, complete with inventory of all items contained. The inventory will be presented to designated weekend staff upon arrival for recording and preparation.

- 6. Contestants are required to bring 1 Auction Basket.
